Working with the Defense Counterintelligence and Human Intelligence Center (DCHC), ASI established a “one-stop shopping” Computer Network Defense (CND) capability for DoD. Enhancing responsiveness, efficiency and supporting the defense and management of the Global Information Grid, the ASI CND service provides DoD users a framework for protecting against, detecting, and responding to nation-state and other malicious hacker activity. Features:

- Available on NIPRNET, SIPRNET, & JWICS
- Service-oriented framework accommodating complete solutions or focused CND requirements
- Establishes repeatable process in line with DoD guidance, regulation, & directives
- Improves organizational common operation picture & situational awareness
 - Integrates DoD CND concept

CONFIGURATION MANAGEMENT

Working with the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) Operational Support Team, ASI established a patch repository available to all .mil users. While patches for vulnerabilities are often publicized and available, they are not quickly or correctly applied. Using the DISA patch repository, software patches can be applied more rapidly, reducing system vulnerability. Features:

- Available on NIPRNET, SIPRNET, & JWICS
- Supports variety of O/S environments & versions
- Supports third party anti-virus software & DoD security tool products
- Maintain patches related to all information assurance vulnerability alerts (IAVAs)
- User access via standard web-browser interface
- Integrates to DISA Gold Disk concept

DESIGN & ARCHITECTURE OF IT INFRASTRUCTURES

Consolidating electronic mail and messaging services, ASI supported a critical building block of the Computing Services Division initiative to move DISA’s U.S. operations to a single domain - helping centralize electronic mail and online messaging and roll out a common enterprise toolset. Applying DISA architectural requirements and best practices, ASI’s approach improved overall IT responsiveness, reduced workloads and costs, and consolidated multiple-mission critical electronic communications systems into a standardized and integrated service.
